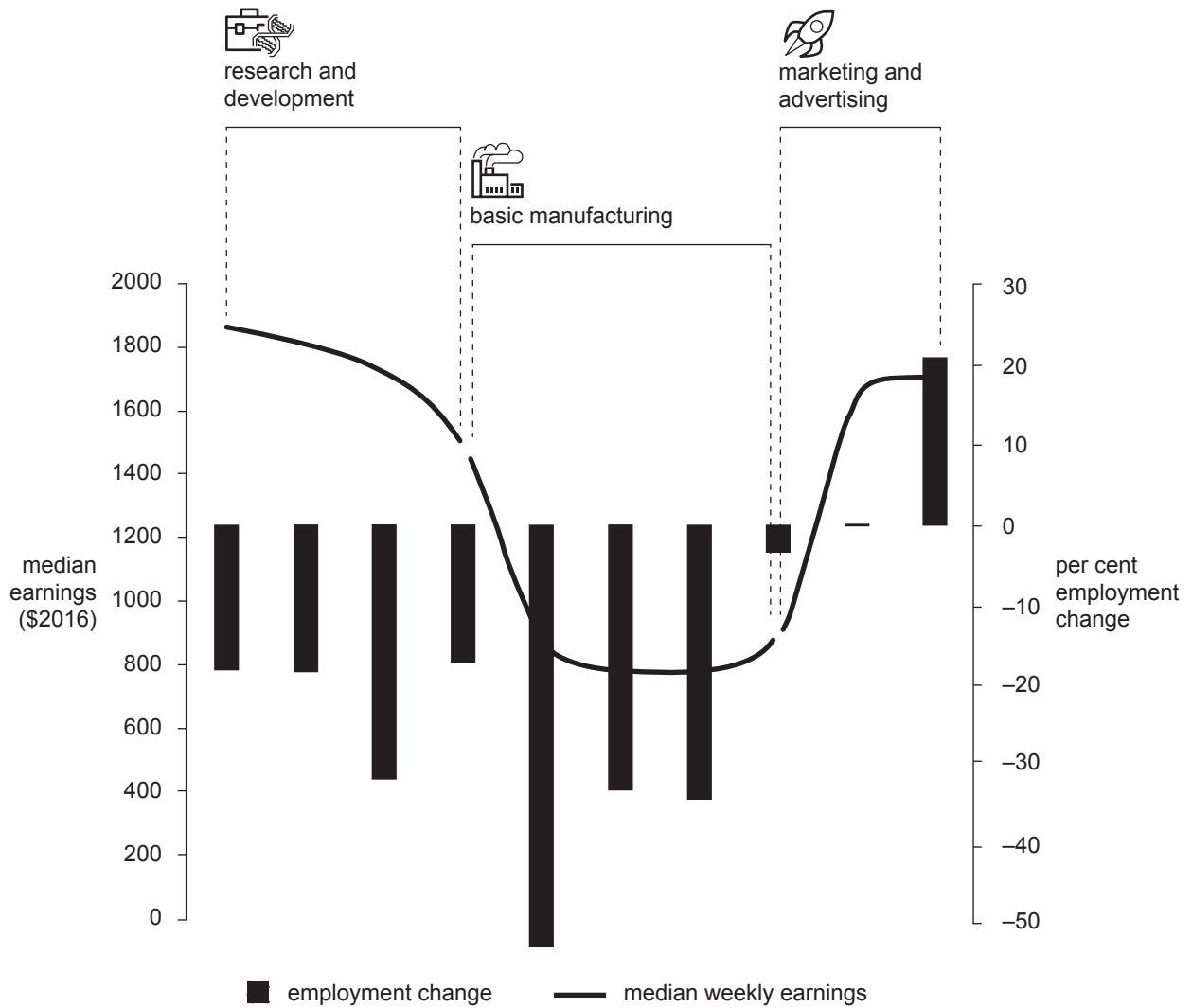


Question 2 (4 marks)
