The following table provides important dates for students enrolled in the VCE and the VCAL.

Monday 30 January	Start of school year for government schools.
Friday 10 February	<p>Final day for lodging, without a late fee, applications for Statements of Marks for all examinations held in 2005.</p> <p>Final day for Principals to lodge requests for Confirmation of Grades for examinations in November 2005.</p> <p>Final day for students to lodge requests to inspect scripts for examinations held in October and November 2005.</p>
Monday 27 February	<p>Enrolment 1 data for VCE Units 3 and 4 due at the VCAA. This should also include as much 2006 VCE Units 1 and 2, VET and VCAL enrolment data as possible. This is the preliminary census date for all 2006 VET and VCAL enrolment data.</p> <p>International Baccalaureate (IB) students for the GAT should also be enrolled.</p>
Friday 10 March	<p>Final day for schools to lodge requests for new or combined examination centres in 2006 and requests for students to sit at centres other than the home school.</p> <p>Final day for schools to lodge written applications for Alternative Instruments and Alternative Works in Music Performance: Solo, and Alternative Works in Music Performance: Group.</p> <p>Final day for schools to lodge the following applications:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – supervisors for the 2006 GAT and VCE examinations – Special Examination Arrangements for June examinations. <p>Final day for notifying the VCAA of alterations to unit results, initial school assessments for School-assessed Coursework and School-assessed Tasks for 2005. After this day a late fee will be charged.</p> <p>Final day for lodging, with a late fee, applications for Statements of Marks for 2005 examinations.</p> <p>End Term 1</p>
Wednesday 15 March to Sunday 26 March	Commonwealth Games
Monday 27 March	Start Term 2
Friday 31 March	<p>Final day for schools to lodge the following applications for examinations held in June:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – requests for students to sit examinations outside Victoria – timetable clashes – earlier starting time – approval of hiring fees for sites in the community used by two or more schools.
Monday 3 April	School Coursework Audit Notification (SCAN) identifying student coursework required for VCE Unit 3 received in schools.
Friday 7 April	All 2005 examination scripts and raw assessment data held at the VCAA will be destroyed on this day.
Friday 14 April to Monday 17 April	Easter Break

Monday 1 May	<p>Enrolment 2 data due at the VCAA. Final date for enrolments on VASS for VET in Schools funding (government schools). The VCAA will use the VCAL data to determine funding to VCAL providers.</p> <p>After this date VASS will not allow schools to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Enrol or withdraw from VCE Unit 3 and 4 sequences. This includes changes to Second Language enrolments. – Enrol or withdraw IB students for the General Achievement Test (GAT). – Enrol returning Interrupted Studies students. <p>Partnership details must be entered on VASS for VCE Unit 3 and VCE Unit 3/4 coursework.</p>
Monday 8 May	First round invoices for full-fee-paying overseas students sent to schools.
Week beginning Monday 15 May	<p>June examination centres available on VASS. Special Examination Arrangements available on VASS.</p>
Monday 29 May	Indicative Grades for June Examinations due at VCAA.
Monday 5 June to Wednesday 7 June	Examinations and GAT held.
Tuesday 13 June	<p>SIAR 1 scores for VCE Studio Arts School-assessed Task 1. After this date VASS will not allow SIAR 1 results to be entered.</p>
Friday 16 June	<p>Applications for exemption from the GAT due at VCAA. End Term 2</p>
Monday 3 July	<p>Start Term 3 School Status Report (SSR) identifying Studio Arts School-assessed Task 1 from SIAR 1 required for review.</p>
Monday 10 July	<p>Enrolment 3 data due at the VCAA. This data should contain 2006 VCE, VET and VCAL enrolment data that is known and available to schools.</p> <p>After this date VASS will not allow schools to withdraw student enrolments from VCE Unit 4.</p> <p>Review of School-assessed Task by visitation in Studio Arts begins.</p>
Friday 21 July	<p>Final day for schools to lodge the following applications for examinations held in October/November:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – requests for new or combined examination centres and for students to sit at centres other than home schools – requests for students to present for examinations outside Victoria – Special Examination Arrangements for October/November examinations – timetable clashes – earlier starting time – approval of hiring fees for sites in the community used by two or more schools.
Monday 24 July	<p>SIAR 2 scores for VCE Unit 3 School-assessed Coursework due at the VCAA. After this date VASS will not allow schools to enter SIAR 2 results. A list of studies can be found on pages 12–13.</p>
Wednesday 26 July	VCE Unit 3 School-assessed Coursework audit material due at VCAA.
Monday 31 July	June examination results and Studio Arts grades available to schools.
Monday 7 August	Arts Performance and LOTE oral component examination advice slips available to schools.

Friday 18 August	<p>Enrolment 4 data due at the VCAA. This data should contain all 2006 VCE, VET and VCAL enrolment data that is known and available to schools.</p> <p>After this date VASS will not allow schools to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – amend VCE VET assessment plan data – enter or withdraw enrolments for units of competence / modules for scored VCE Unit 3 and 4 sequences. <p>Partnership details must be entered on VASS for Unit 4 coursework.</p>
Monday 4 September	<p>October/November examination centres available on VASS.</p> <p>Special Examination Arrangements available on VASS.</p>
Monday 11 September	<p>Indicative Grades for Arts Performance examinations due at VCAA.</p>
Friday 15 September	<p>End Term 3</p> <p>Final day for lodging applications for enrolment in 2007 in Chinese Second Language, Chinese Second Language Advanced, Indonesian Second Language, Japanese Second Language or Korean Second Language.</p>
Monday 2 October	<p>Start Term 4</p>
Monday 2 October to Sunday 29 October	<p>Arts Performance examinations and LOTE examinations: oral component.</p>
Friday 6 October	<p>Enrolment 5 data due at VCAA. This data should be a complete record of all VCE, VCE VET, VET FE and VCAL enrolments of the current year.</p> <p>After this date VASS will not allow schools to enrol or withdraw students in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – VCE Units 1 and 2 – VCE VET and VET FE units of competence/modules – VCAL units
Monday 9 October	<p>SIAR 3 VCE School-assessed Task scores due at the VCAA.</p> <p>Indicative grades for November written examinations are also required.</p> <p>After this date VASS will not allow schools to enter SIAR 3 scores or indicative grades.</p> <p>A list of studies in the cycle can be found on page 13.</p>
Friday 13 October	<p>Final day for lodging requests to inspect scripts for examinations in the June examination period.</p>
Monday 16 October	<p>School Status Report identifying School-assessed Tasks from the SIAR 3 required for review.</p>
Thursday 19 October	<p>LOTE (CCAFL) written examinations</p>
Monday 23 October	<p>Review by visitation of School-assessed Tasks begins.</p>
Wednesday 25 October	<p>VCE Unit 4 School-assessed Coursework audit material due at the VCAA.</p>
Friday 27 October to Friday 17 November	<p>Written examinations held.</p>
Friday 10 November	<p>Final day for Principals to lodge Score Amendments for VCE School-assessed Tasks from SIAR 1.</p> <p>Final day for Principals to lodge requests for Confirmation of Grades for June examination results released to schools.</p> <p>Earliest date School-assessed Tasks in the Arts and Technology may be returned to students.</p>
Monday 13 November	<p>SIAR 4 scores for VCE Unit 4 School-assessed Coursework.</p> <p>After this date VASS will not allow schools to enter SIAR 4 scores.</p>

Monday 20 November

SIAR 5 unit results due at the VCAA.

After this date VASS will not allow schools to enter:

- VCE unit results
- VET unit of competence/module results
- VCE VET coursework task scores
- VCAL unit results

Friday 24 November

Enrolment 6 final date to amend student addresses. After this date no changes to addresses or other student personal details can be accepted.

Monday 11 December

Results available to students.

Final results available to schools.

Results package sent to schools:

- **Statements of Results** for students studying **VCE Units 1 and 2** or **VCAL**
- **Certificates** for students who have successfully completed their **VCE** or **VCAL**
- **VCE VET** and **VET/Further Education Statement of Results** listing units of competence/modules completed for students studying VCE Units 1 and 2 only and VCAL.

Statements of Results for students enrolled in at least one VCE Unit 3 and 4 sequence will be sent to students.

Friday 9 February

Final day for lodging, without a late fee, **applications for Statements of Marks for all examinations held in 2006.**

Final day for Principals to lodge requests for **Confirmation of Grades for examinations in November 2006.**

Final day for lodging **requests to inspect scripts for examinations held in October and November 2006.**

Friday 16 March

Final day for Principals to lodge **Score Amendments** for School-assessed Tasks from SIAR 3 in 2006, and initial school assessments for School-assessed Coursework in 2006.

Final day for lodging, with a late fee, applications for **Statements of Marks** for all examinations held in 2006.

Final day for notifying the VCAA of **alterations to unit results** for students who attempted the VCE or VCAL in 2006. A late fee will be charged after this date.
