In the first instance, colour photograph/s or computer printouts of the final presentations are required and up to three pages (maximum) of **photocopied** folio pages (NOT ORIGINAL FOLIO). Please include design brief. If student is short-listed the complete folio demonstrating the selection and refinement of developmental work and the final presentation/s will be requested.

1. Please place completed forms in A4 plastic sleeve/s. Please fold A3 pages to fit A4 sleeve. Folio pages can be double-sided.
2. Include a photograph/s or printout of final presentations. Please name photographs on back.

4. If work incorporates multimedia, a hard copy sample and CD-ROM/DVDs should be submitted, both clearly labelled.
5. Photographs/photocopies/CD-ROMs will not be returned. **Do not submit in plastic folders or binders, please use A4 plastic sleeves.**
