COLLECTION NOTICE The Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority (VCAA) is a statutory authority established under the *Education and Training Reform Act 2006*. The VCAA has responsibilities relating to both curriculum and assessment across year levels Prep to 12 for all Victorian school students. The collection of the personal information on this form is required to facilitate your application for statement of marks and inspection of examination scripts. Without this information, your application cannot proceed. The personal information you supply in your application is for VCAA internal use only and will not be disclosed to any third party unless required by law. You are able to request access to the personal information we hold about you, and to request that it be corrected. To do so, please contact the Student Records and Results Unit.

Statement of Study Score

This will tell you your actual Graded Assessment scores and explain how your study score was calculated.

- The fee for a Statement of Study Score is \$9.15 per study.

Statement of Examination Marks

This will tell you the mark you received for each question or criterion on the examination and the maximum mark obtainable. It will also tell you the range of scores that correspond to the grade you received.

- The fee for a Statement of Examination Marks is \$9.15 per examination.

Statement of GAT Examination Marks

This will tell you the correct response and your response to each multiple-choice question, your total mark for each multiple-choice component and your mark for the written components.

- The fee for a Statement of GAT Examination Marks is \$9.15.

Inspection of Examination Scripts

You may inspect your October/November written examination scripts or listen to the tape of your Music Performance (Solo or Group) examination. Inspections are not available for LOTE oral examinations, performance examinations in Dance, Drama and Theatre Studies. June examinations are no longer available for inspection.

Scripts do not contain any assessor's marks or comments. You are strongly advised to obtain the relevant Statement of Marks prior to an inspection and arrange to have your teacher present.

There are two options available for inspecting an examination script.

At the VCAA

Inspections may take place at the VCAA. An appointment must be made for the inspection. There is a fee of \$9.80 per script inspected.

At the School

Inspections may take place at your school with the principal's permission. There is a fee of \$20.80 per script inspected. Material will be mailed to the principal. An appointment must be made for the inspection.

Scripts do not contain any assessor's marks or comments. You are strongly advised to obtain the relevant Statement of Marks prior to an inspection and arrange to have your teacher present.

In exceptional circumstances where it can be demonstrated that there is an objective factual error in the marking of an examination script, a principal may make a Student Examination Reassessment Application (SERA), after receiving the recommendation of the subject teacher, on behalf of the student. It is recommended that subject teachers inspect the script with the student if the teacher believes a SERA may be made. The Student Examination Reassessment Application Policy and application form is provided to students when they inspect their scripts.

APPLICATION CLOSING DATES

Applications for Statement of Marks, GAT and Study Score close Friday 17 February 2012.

After this date applications will be accepted until Friday 9 March 2012 with a late fee of \$35.10.

Applications received after this date will not be processed.

Applications for Inspection of October/November Exam Scripts close Friday 17 February 2012.

There is no provision for late applications. Applications received after this date will not be processed.

Applications for Inspection of June Examination Scripts closed on Friday 23 September 2011.
