The program for the end-of-year performance examination for Bagpipes must consist of at least four works. The program must include at least:

- one Piobaireachd
- one Selection March
- one Strathspey and one Reel and/or one Hornpipe and one Jig
- two works which are examples of twentieth and/or twenty-first century music.

This list has been compiled for the Great Highland Bagpipe of Scotland. In this list the Selection Marches, Strathspeys and Reels, Hornpipes are all examples of twentieth or twenty-first century music. Jigs which are examples of twentieth or twenty-first century music are marked with an asterisk (*). All works are to be performed unaccompanied.

Each title listed constitutes one work. The editions listed are for identification purposes only. Any recognised edition is acceptable.
