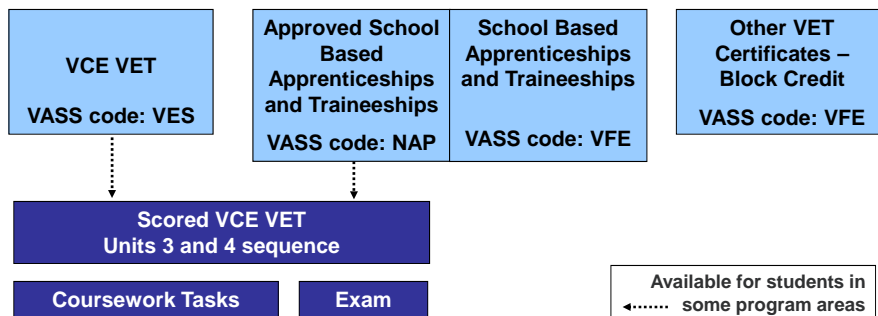

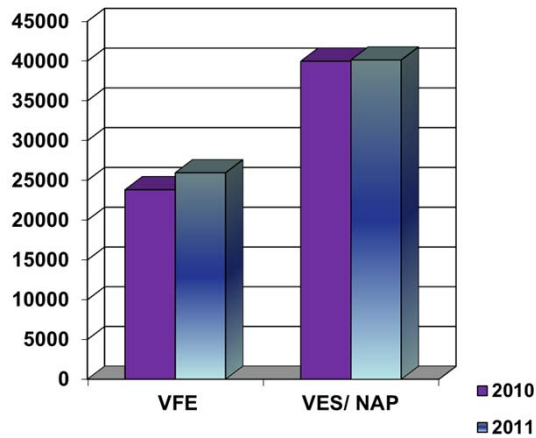

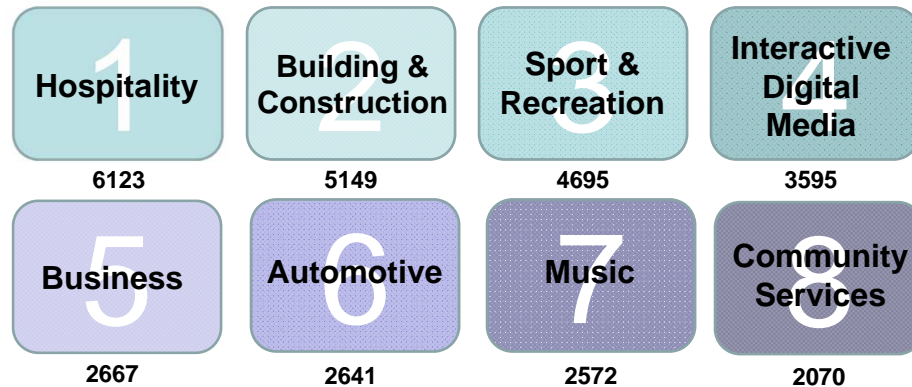

2010 Coursework Audit Findings

- More work required to ensure tasks are compliant with VCAA requirements
- Portfolio task type - the most successful task design
- Sport and Recreation - the most successful results
- Unsatisfactory results are not a fail
- Improvement still required when
 - Clarifying roles within schools and RTOs
 - Communicating

VET Contribution

VCE VET Unit 3 and 4 sequences with scored assessment:

- study scores are scaled and may be included in the calculation of the ATAR
- where scored assessment is available and it is not undertaken, no increment will be available.

VCE VET Unit 3 and 4 sequences with no scored assessment available:

- may be counted as fifth and/or sixth studies.

VET Program Restrictions

- VET results within specified industry area groups (Music & IT)
- Multiple VET results from any industry area (3 per industry)

ATAR

VET Units 3 - 4 sequences from VFE (Block Credit) programs

- From 2011- new rule regarding inclusion of VFE Block Credit increments.

For students who have **previously been awarded an ENTER/ATAR**: Previously obtained VCE and VCE VET results will take precedence over later VFE Block Credit Results. VFE results only contribute to the ATAR (10% increment) when fewer than six VCE and VCE VET results are available.

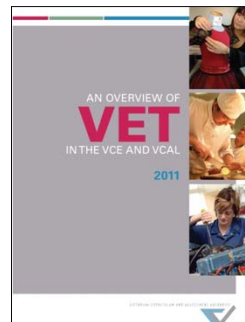
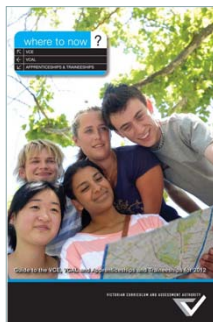
