Performer: Mitsuko Uchida

Album: Mozart: The Piano Sonatas (Universal International Music BV, 2001)

Excerpt 1, first playing (0'30'') - 10 seconds of silence Excerpt 1, second playing (0'30'') - 15 seconds of silence Excerpt 1, third playing (0'30'') - 2 minutes of silence

Excerpt 1 is a piano piece that features a clear melodic line with accompaniment.

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## Excerpt 2

Work: 'Trois Gymnopédies: No. 1, Lent et douloureux'

Composer/Creator: Erik Satie Performer: Khatia Buniatishvili

Album: Labyrinth (Sony Music Entertainment, 2020)

Excerpt 2, first playing (0'35") – 30 seconds of silence Excerpt 1, fourth and final playing (0'30") – 30 seconds of silence Excerpt 2, second playing (0'35") – 1 minute of silence Excerpt 2, third and final playing (0'35") – 3 minutes of silence
