

#### Review of the Study Design

- June 2019: Monitoring survey for public feedback
- 2020 2021: Writing panel appointed, review process
- April May 2021: Consultation draft published
- June August 2021: Feedback considered
- October 2021-January 2022: VCAA board and VRQA approval of final Study Design
- Term 1, 2022: Study Design published

#### **Summary of changes**

#### Culture and Society in Chinesespeaking Communities strand

(Area of Study 1)

- Topics have been reviewed, redistributed and renamed to facilitate a more effective and more logical skill development.
- Students are introduced to key concepts of philosophy at Units 1 and 2 level, and this foregrounds the development of student understanding of philosophy and the other topics that follow in Units 3 and 4.
- Some terminology has been updated.
- Some adjustments to the key knowledge and the key skills to support these changes.
- Some adjustments to the Unit 3 and 4 tasks to support these changes.
- Small reduction to the mark allocation for Outcome 1, in Unit 3 and in Unit 4

#### **Summary of changes**

#### Chinese Language strand

(Areas of Study 2 and 3)

- Terminology has been updated
- Topics are no longer prescribed in the specific outcomes
- Teachers will now use the table of *Prescribed topics and suggested subtopics*
- Very minor adjustments have been made to the prescribed topics themselves
- The character list and the grammar list have been updated and refined
- List of text types has been reviewed
- Imaginative writing has been added to outcomes in both Unit 2 and Unit 4
- Viewing has been added to some outcomes in both Unit 2 and Unit 4
- The Unit 2 oral role play task that requires students to make arrangements has been moved to Unit 4. It has been expanded slightly.
- Key knowledge and key skills have been updated to support these changes
- Small increase to the mark allocation for Outcome 3, in Unit 3 and in Unit 4

#### **Unit 1 and 2 outcomes**

All assessments at Units 1 and 2 are school-based. Procedures for assessment of levels of achievement in Units 1 and 2 are a matter for school decision.

For each outcome in Units 1 and 2, teachers may choose one of the suggested tasks listed in the Study Design.

Where teachers allow students to choose between tasks, they must ensure that the tasks they set are of comparable scope and demand.

#### **Prescribed texts**

- Prescribed texts are used to support the teaching of content in Area of Study 1 at Unit 3 and 4 level
- Section 3 of the written examination will be based on these prescribed texts.
- Prescribed text list is published on the Study Page

#### Selection of prescribed texts

- 2021: Text advisory panel recruited and appointed
- Term 1, 2022: Panel met and considered a range of suitable texts
- April 2022: VCAA Board approval of list
- Term 2, 2022: 2023-2024 Prescribed Text List published on VCE Chinese Language Culture and Society study page



#### **External assessment**

- The level of achievement for Units 3 and 4 is also assessed by two end-ofyear examinations, which will contribute 50 per cent to the study score.
- Oral examination: approximately 15 minutes
- Written examination: 2 hours plus 15 minutes reading time
