Continuing students will be required to complete this UoC if they are seeking to be awarded the CUA30915 Certificate III in Music Industry.</p> <p>RTOs should make arrangements for the delivery and competency assessment of this UoC in addition to the students Units 3+4 sequence. Schools will need to enrol students on VASS into this UoC, which sits in the Units 1+2 structure.</p> <p>The UoCs undertaken in 2016 or earlier that are deemed equivalent can be used in the issuing of the qualification by the RTO following their normal processes but should not be enrolled into again on VASS.</p> <p>Performance Specialisation for continuing students</p> <p>The UoC <i>CUAMPF302 Prepare for performances</i> is now compulsory in the Units 3+4 sequence. The equivalent UoC was previously an elective within the Units 1+2 structure. Students who have previously completed this UoC must enrol into the <i>CUAMPF302 Prepare for performances</i> as part of the compulsory Units 3+4 sequence in order to achieve a study score. This UoC is vital in preparing students for their performance exam and while the teaching and learning for some students may have occurred in previous years, this UoC must be included in the student's enrolment and scored assessment tasks in the one enrolment year.</p> <p>A student who is not enrolled into this UoC will not have a valid assessment plan and will not be eligible for a study score.</p> <p>Students commencing in 2017 and beyond</p> <p>All students commencing a VCE VET Music Industry program in January 2017 and beyond must comply with the requirements outlined in the program extract and enrol in CUA20615 Certificate II in Music Industry or CUA30915 Certificate III in Music Industry. Students may undertake training from multiple specialisations from this program, concurrently or across multiple years.</p>
