

CIVICS AND CITIZENSHIP PROFESSIONAL LEARNING PROGRAM FOR TEACHERS

This free short course will enhance teacher capacity to implement the Victorian Curriculum Civics and Citizenship Levels 3-10, with special attention to the development of pedagogical content knowledge in the curriculum.

ABOUT THE COURSE

As a collaboration between Monash University and Australian Catholic University, this pilot professional learning program is funded by the Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority. The four week course will focus on content knowledge and classroom practice for teaching Civics and Citizenship. Participants will have the option of either completing the 8 modules of this course entirely online, or via blended learning. Participants who enrol in the blended learning offering will complete 4 modules in a one day face-to-face workshop (in either Melbourne or Ballarat), and complete the remaining 4 modules online.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

This course is for all primary and secondary school teachers from government, Catholic, and independent schools. Participants will have the opportunity to enhance their pedagogical content knowledge through evidence-based best practice, including opportunities for collaboration, modelling, and feedback.

This free short course is a unique learning opportunity for teams of teachers. Teaching teams from individual schools are encouraged to enrol.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

To enhance teacher capacity in areas of

- Implementing the Victorian Curriculum Civics and Citizenship Levels 3-10
- Developing political, legal and sociological content knowledge related to the curriculum
- Pedagogy and classroom practice for Civics and Citizenship, including strategies for teaching the curriculum through contemporary issues
- Enacting student voice and agency
- Effective identification and use of resources
- Approaches to assessment tools and tasks.

COURSE DETAILS

Date: 6 September - 15 October, 2021

Duration: A total time commitment of 10 hours.

Delivery: Participants can complete this course as either:

- Online, or
- Blended (participants will be required to attend one whole-day workshop in either Melbourne on 13 September, or in Ballarat on 15 September 2021).

Cost: Free

ADDITIONAL COURSE INFORMATION

- Spaces are limited to 100 participants.
- One day of CRT is provided for every participant. This will be payable to the school upon the teacher's completion of the program.
- Regional teachers may also apply to have some of their travel costs to the face-to-face workshop in Ballarat reimbursed.
- Participants will be awarded a Digital Badge, an electronic online record of the learner's achievements that outlines the details/evidence of how learning was achieved.
- Participants will be asked to complete a course evaluation form upon completion.
