SECTION 2 – Reading, listening and creating text**Instructions for Section 2****Texts 2A and 2B, Question 2 (20 marks)**

At the end of the three minutes, Text 2B, the listening text, will be played. The text will be played twice. There will be a short break between the first and second playings of the text. You may make notes at any time.

Your response **must** be based on both texts.
