Design scenario

As more and more people choose to go on holidays in rural and regional destinations of Victoria, the trend towards luxury camping has become increasingly popular. People are also choosing to go on holidays without the need for air travel, because it is environmentally damaging. One of the options available to holiday-makers is an upmarket form of camping known as 'glamping'. This word is a blend of the words 'glamorous' and 'camping'. Glamping holidays typically include staying in private, tent-like accommodation surrounded by nature and open space, for example, in coastal regions and in forests. Glamping sites are usually equipped with comfortable beds and multipurpose furniture inside a tent.

A newly established Victorian business that focuses on selling luxury products that enhance the glamping experience has invited designers to develop a range of high-quality, creative, modern, innovative products that will reflect the surrounding natural environment.
