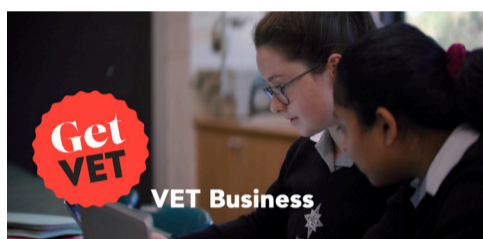

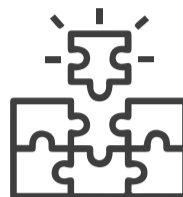

- VET Information and Communications Technology

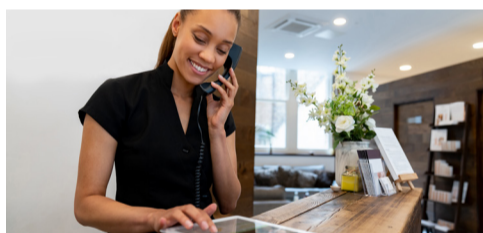
